The Court dismisses as moot the petitions for review in the interlocutory appeals from denials of pleas to the jurisdiction in Cause Nos. 01-0728 and 01-0810. The Court conditionally grants the petition for writ of mandamus in Cause No. 01-0827. Motions for rehearing will not be entertained. See TEX. R. APP. P. 64.1. The Court's stay orders of September 7, 2001, are lifted.
