ORDER

Pursuant to the Court's most recent order regarding trial time and order of presentation of evidence (Dkt. # 1018), the parties filed advisories providing their estimates of the number of trial hours needed for each of the four segments on liability issues. Based on the parties' estimates, trial on the 2011 Texas House plan will last at least 35 hours, and possibly up to 52 hours. The Court has therefore determined that, subject to any rulings on pending matters such as motions to dismiss and for summary

judgment, it will hear evidence only on the 2011 Texas House plan in the first segment of trial, from Monday July 14 to Saturday July 19. The next three segments of trial, which include challenges to the 2011 Congressional plan, 2013 Texas House plan, and the 2013 Congressional plan, will take place on dates to be determined in the near future. The parties will be notified when dates for the remaining segments of trial have been determined.¹ The parties should prepare for trial accordingly.

The pretrial conference remains scheduled for 8:30 a.m. on July 2, 2014.
